Bloorview School provides specialized educational programs for students from across the province who require intensive rehabilitation as a result of surgery, chronic illness, acquired brain injury, or complex medical needs. The length of hospital stay and school enrolment depends on medical and therapy needs. The rate of recovery varies from student to student. Therefore, the turnover of students in the classroom is frequent and ongoing.

Bloorview School teachers work collaboratively with colleagues and with multidisciplinary teams. Our teachers are committed to professional learning and leadership. The successful candidate will have a growth mindset, be versatile, flexible, and able to teach in a multi-grade classroom setting.

The Middle School Teacher (Grades 6-9) will:

- Assess students based on current needs
- Develop and implement an Individualized Education Plan with appropriate modifications and accommodations
- Differentiate instruction and integrate assistive technology to support a range of student abilities
- Collaborate with the multidisciplinary team from Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital
- Provide ongoing communication with the family and home school
- Write education reports and report cards
- Support the transition of students from Bloorview School to community schools
- Foster student self-esteem, independence, advocacy, and wellbeing
- Support students by teaching strategies for self-regulation and emotional regulation
- Complete other related duties as assigned

Skills and Qualifications:

- Broad knowledge of Junior and Intermediate curriculum
- Full understanding of differentiated instruction and assessment practices
- Proficiency using assistive technology with students who have physical disabilities and/or learning disabilities
